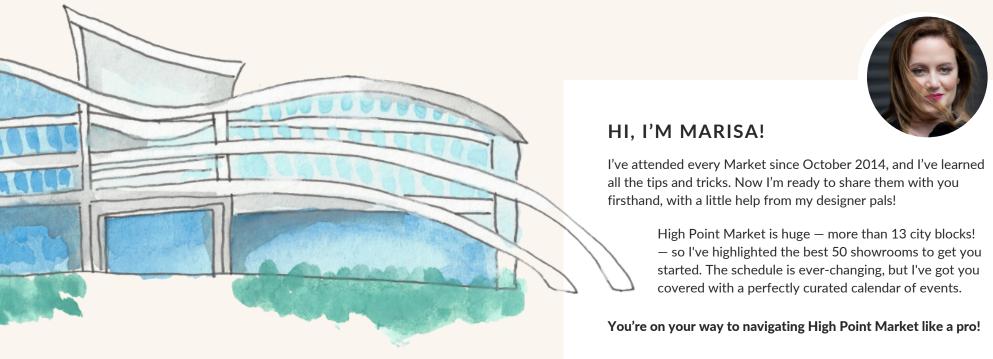

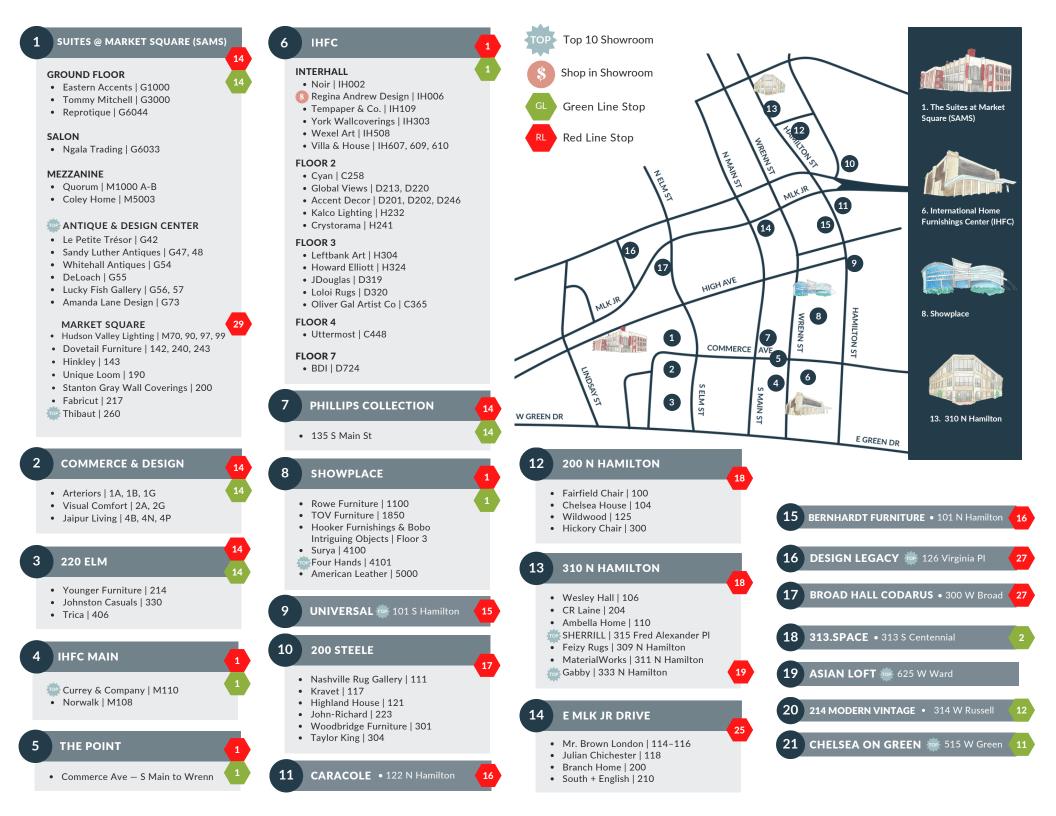

Hold off on the alcohol until the end of the day. It can be tempting to have a glass of prosecco at every showroom that offers it to you but it will just make you sleepy and kill your momentum! Also, and this is kind of random, but pack sunscreen for your face!

This may sound old fashioned but I always bring business cards with me! I keep them in my lanyard and it's a great way to connect with new people and vendors. In this digital age it's refreshing to use a physical card as a nice brand touch point. But also, sneakers!

Market days are long—often 8am-8pm—so you can really take advantage of extended hours.

Day 1, I'd hit outlier showrooms and maybe a multibrand hub like Market Square/Suites at Market Square. The next day, hit the heart of the action, the Hamilton Wrenn district, take a spin through 200 Steele and Showplace, and around the main quad. With so much to see, two days fly by—but don't stress! High Point is open year-round, and many brands welcome appointments.

Lots of showrooms, especially those with antiques and one-of-a-kinds, open well before Saturday so you can really get a jumpstart on it all. Also, you will see what you see and who you see. It's likely that you won't get to it all, but never fear, High Point is here.

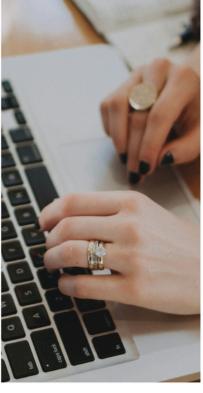

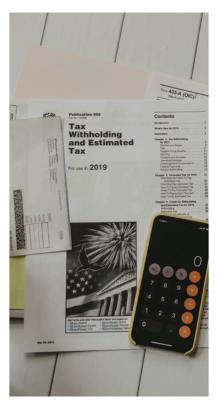

I plan my days by zones so I'm not crisscrossing all over town. And I take advantage of the free hotel shuttles and the "Go Anywhere" vans—they're lifesavers for getting around without the hassle. Also, I pack snacks and a refillable water bottle so I'm not wasting time (or money) standing in line for basics.

To save money, find the FREE food! There really is no need to spend any money on food while you're at Market. But if you don't plan it well you could miss the meals and get pretty hangry! Find out which showrooms offer breakfast (I like Universal's Cafe) and always plan where you'll be eating lunch. There are food trucks where you can buy food but it really isn't necessary if you take advantage of all the free food!

You can also use the free hotel shuttle to get to and from Market daily! I've rented a car before and it really wasn't necessary. When it comes to saving time Do as I say and not as I do - map out your days before you arrive. I never remember to do this and always feel like I waste time trying to decide where to go next LOL.

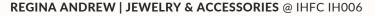
